RE: Filling of Detective Position

1. Our current Detective resigned from the department for an opportunity in another agency. The position is now open.
2. The position was posted, per Union Contract for 10 days. No qualified union employee expressed an interest in the position.
3. By default, the position will now be opened to qualified persons outside the union staffing of the department.

The authorized starting rate of pay for the new union employee at \$26.00 per hours with full benefits. This is based on 2081 hours per year (\$54,106 year). Based on experience the starting wage maybe higher at 6yrs – \$26.50, 9yrs – \$27.00). This year, officers paid \$124 month towards Healthcare, but a buyout is currently available. The applicant must have 3 years of active full-time Law Enforcement experience and be currently State Certified as a Wisconsin Officer.

The detective works a 10.5-hour workday from 9am to 7:30pm on a rotation of 5 days on duty followed by 4 days off duty, 4 days on and 4 days off. The probationary period is 18 months. The yearly uniform allowance is \$450 on the second year, and the position is also required to maintain a uniform and work a patrol shift occasionally. Policy requires daily dress to be professional business attire. The detective is assigned an unmarked vehicle that can be a take-home squad if they reside in the Village. They are assigned an individual office and equipment. The detective works with limited supervision in accordance with policies. Vacation equals 42.5 hours after 1 year, Holidays are built into the schedule but 27.5 hours of additional personal time off, is allotted per year.
