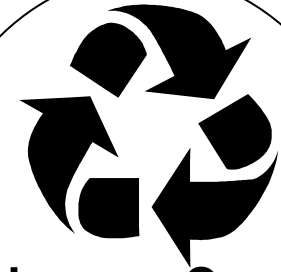

Guidelines for Recycling Materials

Hallie Area Recycling Center

Recyclables:

Recyclable items **MUST BE CLEAN AND SORTED** by type into separate containers. Recyclables **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED** if not clean and properly prepared.

☆ SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS ON SITE!

☆ VIOLATORS WILL BE FINED & PROSECUTED!

Newsprint: Bundle newspaper and tie with strong string or place in paper grocery bags. Inserts in the newspaper, even those on glossy paper, may be left with the paper for recycling.

Magazines, Paper and Cardboard: All glossy material. Includes phone books, file folders, grocery bags, office and computer paper. Stack 9 to 12 inches high and tie in two directions with string, NOT WIRE. May also be bagged in brown paper grocery bags. **Corrugated and Gray Cardboard** such as soda cases and cereal boxes must be flattened.

Glass and Plastic: Remove caps, metal rings, etc. and clean thoroughly. Do not break. **Clear, green or brown** glass only. Paper labels may be left on. **Types 1# & 2# plastics only, no Styrofoam** (ex: hot drink cups). **Keep bags separate.**

Aluminum Cans: Rinse and place in a bag or box. Other aluminum is also accepted at the center.

Tin Cans: Rinse to remove food residue inside and out. Place in grocery bag or cardboard box.

Yard Waste: Grass, leaves and limbs 2" or smaller accepted. Brush okay, must be pure. Wood- **NO nails, NO treated or painted lumber, NO stumps.**

Scrap Metal: Scrap metal, brass and copper accepted. Easy-to-handle metal items such as car parts, pipes, faucets, tools, bike parts, etc. will be accepted.

Automotive Oil and Batteries: Used automotive oil and batteries are accepted at the center.

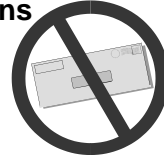
Tires: The price of the tires is determined by the size and if a rim is included or not. Passenger car tires through 15" without a rim are \$2.50. Passenger car tires through 15" with a rim are \$4.00. Car tires 16-17" without rim are \$4.00. Car tires 16-17" with rim are \$6.00. Truck tires 18-19" without rim are \$6.00. Truck tires 18-19" with rim are \$9.00. Truck tires 20-22.5" without rim are \$9.00. Truck tires 20-22.5" with a rim are \$14.00.

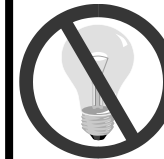
