



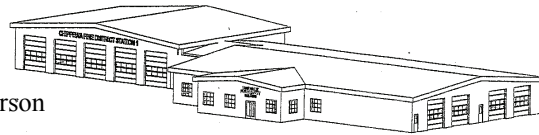

Proposed Public Safety Building

The Building Committee is back in session and looking at plans to construct the much needed Public Safety/Municipal building. In the past few months, the Committee has met with Short Elliot Hendrickson (SEH) to design a Public Safety/Municipal building for the Village that will be able to fill the needs of the growing Fire and Police Departments. The Committee looked at building this in stages or all at once and has an initial concept drawing to present to the Village residents. The Committee is cognizant of the difficult financial state that many Municipalities and their residents are experiencing and is pursuing additional information to help reduce the cost of this project. The need for this building has not changed since the last referendum, so the Committee is striving to provide as much information to the Village residents as possible to make an informed decision.

Police Department

The Police Department would like to remind residents that winter parking restrictions are in effect from November 15 to March 31 of each year between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Exceptions to this winter parking restriction may be requested by contacting the Police Department prior to engaging in the prohibited parking. A determination if the overnight restriction can be waived is based on road and weather conditions and if the parked vehicle poses a traffic hazard. If a weather emergency is declared because of snow, freezing rain, sleet, ice, snow drifts, or other weather events, or its after-effects, all parking is prohibited on the roadway and right-of-way. Except as restricted above normal year long Village-wide prohibited parking in Commercial and Residential throughways is as follows; No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle upon the paved and/or travelled portion of any roadway, public street or highway in the Village of Lake Hallie unless there is at least fifteen (15) feet of the travelled portion of the roadway that is unrestricted for the use of other motor vehicles.

FIRE/EMS: Keep hydrants and address markers clear of snow. If the address marker is broke call Chippewa County Addressing at (715) 726-7930.

Dog Licensing

The owner of any dog(s) **FIVE MONTHS OF AGE OR OLDER** shall annually on the **FIRST** day of **JANUARY** obtain a license from the Village Clerk/Treasurer. **WRITTEN PROOF** of current rabies vaccination **MUST** be included with the application. Applications made after **March 31st** of each year shall be assessed a late fee set by the State Statues and a possible citation. First offense violation fees are \$200.50. There is a maximum of **three (3)** dogs. (Ordinance 5.1.04 (6))
