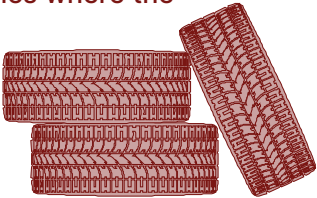

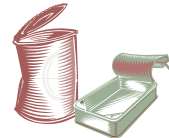

- No window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, or other glass.

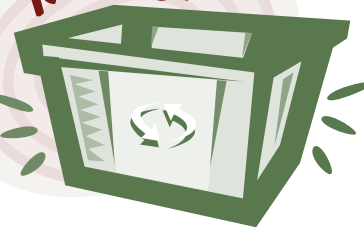


#### Plastic
